Tailgating Information for Homecoming + Reunion Weekend 2024

Winthrop is excited to host tailgating for Homecoming and Reunion Weekend! Details below for what to expect for tailgating at the Winthrop Coliseum for the Saturday, Nov. 9. Visit www.winthrop.edu/homecoming for more details.

TAILGATE RESERVATIONS

Tailgating spots will be available for purchase beginning Thursday, Sept. 5 at 10 a.m. The map of tailgate areas and tailgate reservations can be found via the QR code below or visit winthropeagles.com. All tailgate spots will be reserved on a first come, first-served basis. Tailgate spots will not be available for purchase after Sunday, Nov. 3. Tailgating is rain or shine. Tailgating spots are prepaid, and refunds will not be issued.

There will be two designated tailgating areasthe alumni/family zone and the student/alumni zone. Please refer to the tailgate map and the following descriptions to consider which section will be most desirable before you purchase.

Standard 30'x40' spots in the Alumni/Family Zone

- \$100 per spot
- Suitable for multiple families or a single family. Adjacent to the Alumni Association Kids Zone.
- DJ's are not allowed in these spots.
- Limit two spots per purchase.

Standard 30'x40' spots in the Student/Alumni Zone

- \$100 per spot
- Suitable for single groups.
- DJ's are not allowed in these spots.
- Limit two spots per purchase.

XL 80'x 40' spots in the Student/Alumni Zone

- \$225 per spot
- Suitable for large/combined groups.
- DJ's are allowed in these spots and must comply to the noise policy in the tailgating policy. Non explicit lyrics must be played.
- Limit one spot per purchase.

TAILGATING TIME

Tailgating will be from 10:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 9. Those who have purchased a tailgate spot will have the opportunity to set up their tailgate on Friday, Nov. 8 from 4-8 p.m. Friday setup requires signature on the Homecoming Setup Waiver, which acknowledges that tailgate setup is being done at your own risk.

PARKING

Parking will be cash only, \$20 per vehicle. Each tailgate spot purchased includes a single parking pass for one vehicle. Parking attendants will collect the parking fee until 4 p.m. and direct participants to parking lots and/or the tailgating areas.

TAILGATING POLICY AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Please refer to the tailgating policy for information about conduct, prohibited activities and approved amenities. The tailgating policy and other Homecoming information can be found at www.winthrop. edu/homecoming.

Per the tailgating policy, attendees must remove their own trash from their tailgating space—whether in the parking lots or in the designated tailgating area. If excess trash and/or other items are left in reserved spaces, the individual reserving the space may be fined. After clean up and before leaving the area, time stamp a photo of your reserved spot for your records in case you are charged a fine. Trash receptacles will be provided, but bringing one's own trash bags is encouraged.

Law enforcement and emergency medical personnel will be on site for the duration of tailgating and games.
