4. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application are considered the same designator.
5. Students should complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.
6. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
7. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
