If you have already satisfied the requirement with a general education course you may take an elective in its place on the semester plan. CSCI 327 and WRIT 465 are suggested courses not requirements
- 3 **ELECTIVES** are courses that do not meet specific degree requirements, but are needed to meet the graduation requirement of 120 hours. Electives can include courses for an additional concentration or minor.
- 4 **Courses in BOLD** are only offered in the specified semester. Ex. CSCI 475 is only offered in the Fall.
