- 2 Courses satisfying **Intensive Writing, Constitution, and Oral Communication** can be shared among other General Education requirements. If you have already satisfied the requirement with a general education course you may take an elective in its place on the semester plan.
- 3 **ELECTIVES** are courses that do not meet specific degree requirements, but are needed to meet the graduation requirement of 120 hours. Electives can include courses for an additional concentration or minor.
- 4 **Courses in BOLD** are only offered in the specified semester. Ex. ECON 315 is only offered in the Fall.
