Create Adaptive Release Grade Criteria

Overview

This tutorial will explain how to create **Adaptive Release Grade Criteria**. The Adaptive Release feature allows you to hide course content until various criteria are met. One type of criteria you can set is Grade Criteria, which will display content only after an item attempt, item score, or a calculated column is equal to a specific value. It is useful for creating progressive units.

Adaptive Release rules with grade criteria allow you to release content based on an item attempt, item score, or a calculated column. Use these steps to add a grade criterion to an advanced adaptive release rule.



Quick Steps

Navigate to Item > Item Options > Adaptive Release: Advanced > Create Rule > Submit > Create Criteria > Grade > Select Column > Select Condition

Step 1

Navigate to the activity. Open the Item Options menu [1] by clicking on the Item Options arrow that follows the activity's title, and then select "Adaptive Release: Advanced" [2].



Step 2

On the Adaptive Release: Advanced page, click the Create Rule button [3] on the Action Bar.



Step 3

On the Add Rule page, click the *Submit* button. Optionally, use the Rule Name field to name this Adaptive Release Criteria.




Step 4

On the Manage Criteria page, hover over *Create Criteria* [4] on the Action Bar, and then select "Grade" [5].




Step 5

On the Grade page, use the dropdown box to "Select a Grade Center column" for this criterion [6]. The column you choose is considered the prerequisite to release this activity.



Step 6

In the Select Condition area, use the radio buttons to select one of three conditions:



- 7. Select "User has at least one attempt for this item" to release the content based on a submitted attempt rather than a score achieved, i.e. completion.
- 8. Select "Score" or "Percent," followed by Less Than, Greater Than, or Equal To and a numeric score in the final box to release the content after a score/percent threshold.
- 9. Select "Score Between" or "Percent Between," and then type values into the two boxes to represent the lower and upper limit of the score/percent range.



Step 7

Click the Submit button.



Note

To edit, delete, or copy an Adaptive Release Rule, repeat this process starting with Step 2.
