

Replacing Techsmith with Panopto in your Blackboard Ultra Course

Overview

This tutorial will explain how to replace Techsmith videos in your Blackboard course with Panopto videos. This tutorial only covers the steps for videos that existed in Techsmith prior to May 15, 2022 and were part of the official video migration from Techsmith to Panopto. This tutorial is for Blackboard Ultra Course Experience only. Please review the [Original tutorial](#) if you are using the Blackboard Original Course experience.

Step 1

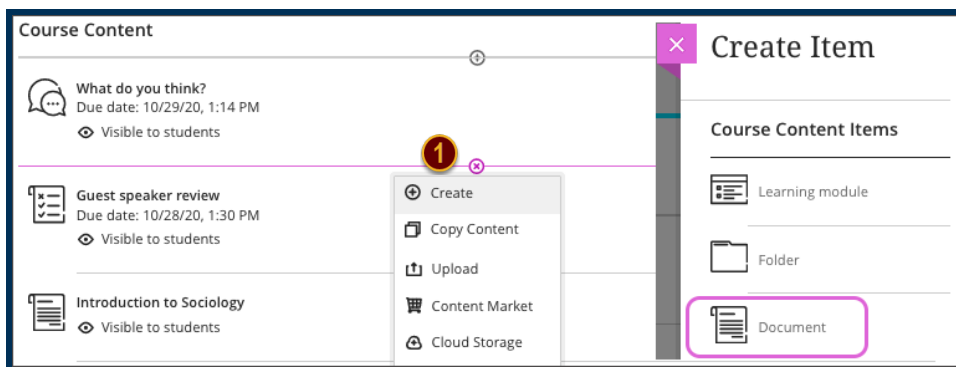
Provision your Blackboard course for Panopto. These steps are provided in the [Getting Started with Panopto](#) tutorial - step 2 only.

Step 2

Navigate to the first instance of a TechSmith video in your course. Highlight the title of the video and copy it using the CTRL+C (windows) or command+C (mac) keyboard shortcut (or by right-clicking with your mouse and selecting copy).

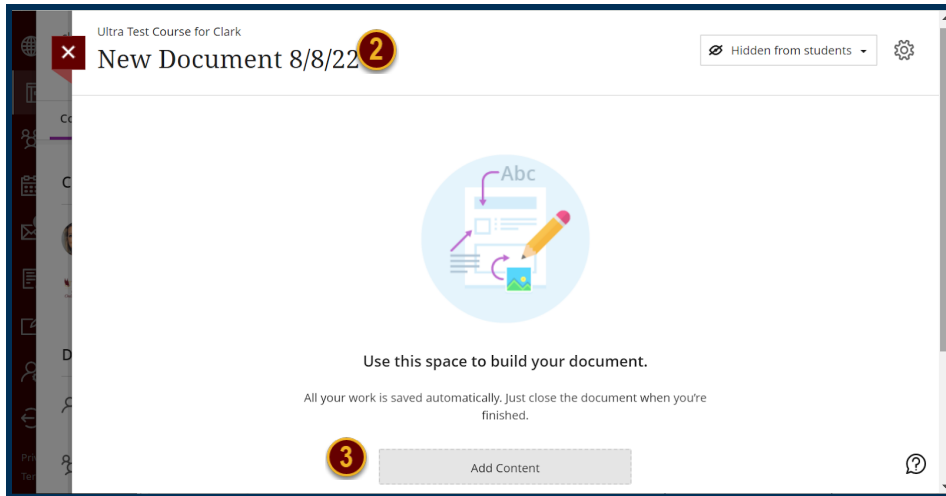
Step 3

Click the Add Content icon [1] on the Course Content page and select Create. In the peek tab that opens on the right, select Document.



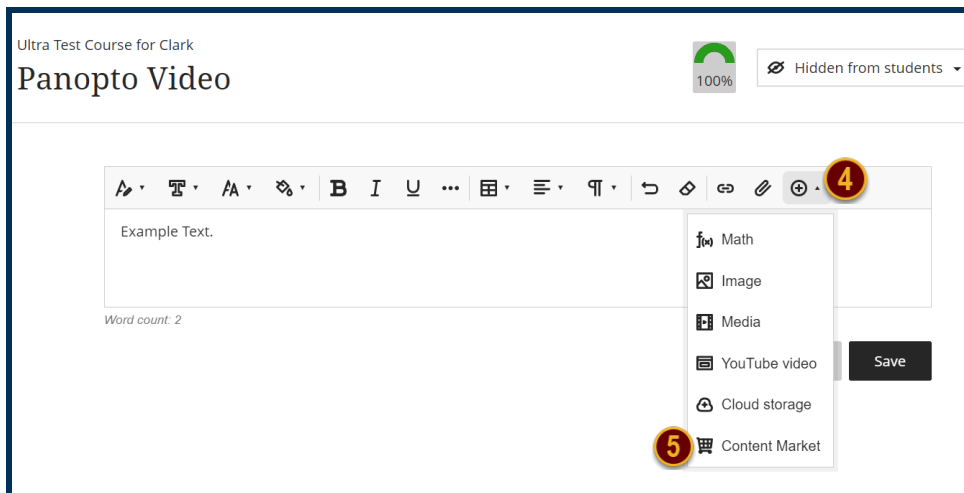
Step 4

In the Document page, paste the title at the top [2]. Click on the Add Content button [3] and type in any desired text in the text box.



Step 5

Click on the Insert Content icon [4] in the Text Editor menu. Select Content Market [5].

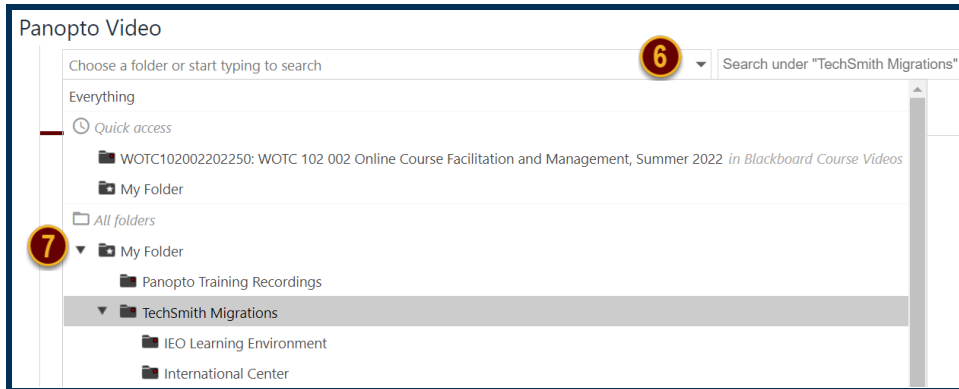


Step 6

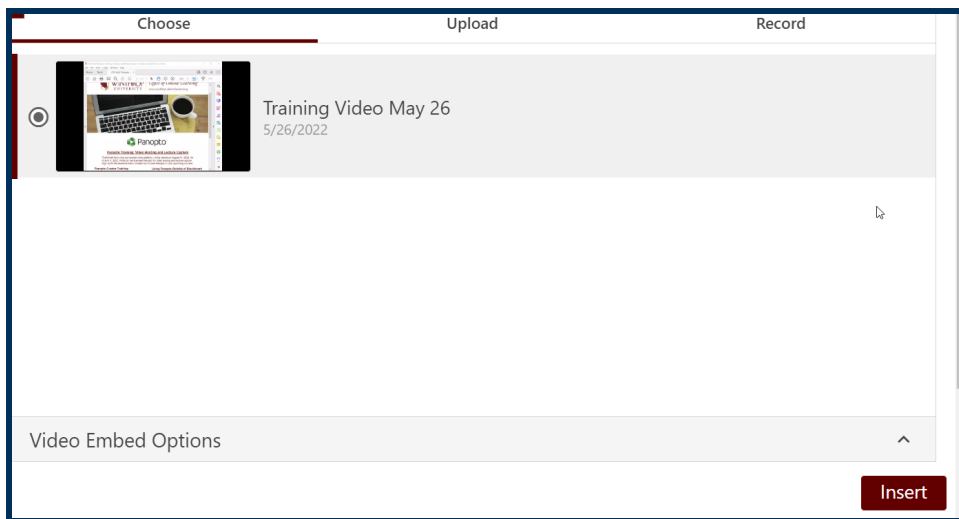
On the Content Market page, click on the Panopto Video Embed Tool (ULTRA ONLY) tile.

Step 7

Click on the upper left drop down menu where you see your course name [6]. In the list of folders, click the arrow next to My Folder [7], then select the TechSmith Migrations folder or a subfolder within it. The migrated videos will appear on the page.



Click the radio button for the desired video, then click the Insert button.



Complete the Create Document page, then click Save.

Step 8

Remove or hide the TechSmith video on your content area page. We would recommend hiding the TechSmith videos on your content area page until you have embedded all of the Panopto videos in the course.
