

RISK/MITIGATION

Failure to secure full CHE approval for AI and the Ed.D. could delay their implementation or block the development all together. Ed.D. faced opposition in CHE ACAP. Failure to finalize the development of the software engineering curriculum and clear all Faculty Conference steps could delay its implementation. Game Design and Supply Chain and Logistics are concentrations inside of degree programs, which could lead to slower enrollment gains.
